Atterbury Signs First Detroit Terminal Bill

Freight bill No. 1, the first issued by M. L. Hampton, P. R. R. freight agent at the new Detroit Produce Terminal, has been countersigned by W. W. Atterbury, President of the Pennsylvania Railroad.

This freight bill is highly prized by the consignee, Ben S. Schwartz, who is a prominent Pennsylvania Railroad patron at Detroit. President Atterbury placed his signature across the "Paid" stamp at the bottom of the freight bill near the signature of Freight Agent Hampton.

The bill covered the shipment of a carload (448 crates) of peaches from Americus, Ga., to Detroit, for the Ben S. Schwartz Co.
